ASSEMBLY/SERVICE/INSPECTION

- ☐ SEALED BATTERY - Check voltage, re-charge as required
- ☐ CONVENTIONAL BATTERY - Open Vent/Fill/Charge/Install/Route vent line properly/Trim vent line if necessary
- ☐ TIRE PSI - Verify tire pressure

VERIFY TORQUE VALUES

- ☐ Handlebar Bracket Bolts (4) - Torque to 10-12 ft. lbs. (13-16 Nm)
- ☐ Front and Rear Wheel Nuts - Torque
- ☐ Master Cylinder Mounting Bolts

VERIFY LUBRICATION LEVELS

- ☐ Front and Rear Gearcase -Add oil if needed
- ☐ Transmission -Add oil if needed
- ☐ Engine Oil - Add oil if needed - if engine oil is found to be above full mark, refer to Service Manual for oil system priming procedure.
- ☐ Perform general visual inspection to ensure no lines are kinked or pinched
- ☐ Check fluid level in brake master cylinder(s) (must be between MIN and MAX marks)
- ☐ Check coolant level in recovery bottle

- ☐ Inspect steering post cotter pin
- ☐ Inspect A-arm ball joint cotter pins
- ☐ Inspect tie rod end cotter pins and jam nuts
- ☐ Check lights for operation (high/low) and correct adjustment, tighten adjustment hardware where applicable
- ☐ Check operation of dump box (if applicable)
- ☐ Complete applicable bulletins, recalls or factory directed modification(s)

TEST RIDE

- ☐ ENGINE - Starting / acceleration / smoothness / Idle
- ☐ AUXILIARY SHUT-OFF SWITCH - Test for proper operation
- ☐ BRAKES - Check for smooth and positive operation (bleed if necessary)
- ☐ THROTTLE - Turn handlebars left to right while engine is running in neutral to check for correct and smooth operation

- ☐ ETC - Check for proper operation/verify throttle freeplay
- ☐ TRANSMISSION - Shift gear selector into high, low and reverse, checking for proper engagement
- ☐ AWD SWITCH - Check for proper operation (if applicable)
- ☐ REVERSE SPEED LIMITER - Check operation and override control

- ☐ CLUTCH and TRANSMISSION - Check for smooth shifting / lights must match gears
- ☐ SPEEDOMETER / INDICATOR PANEL - Check for proper operation (if applicable)
- ☐ SUSPENSION/STEERING - Confirm adjustments/stability/smoothness
- ☐ LEAKAGE - Oil / Exhaust / Fuel / Coolant

WARNING

Set-up and pre-delivery service must be performed by an authorized Polaris dealer. Proper pre-delivery is essential to reliability of the vehicle and to rider safety. An error made by the person setting up and servicing a new vehicle can result in damage to the machine or injury to the rider. Perform all items correctly and completely. Observe all safety precautions and use common sense when assembling this vehicle. Avoid contact with moving parts. Severe personal injury to the person assembling this vehicle or to a bystander could result.



In order to perform service work efficiently and to prevent costly errors, the technician must thoroughly familiarize him/herself with procedures before beginning. A knowledge of mechanical theory, tool use and shop procedures is necessary to perform the service work safely and satisfactorily.



Watch for sharp edges which can cause personal injury. Protect hands with gloves when working with sharp components.



If difficulty is encountered in removing or installing a component, look to see if a cause for the difficulty can be found. If it is necessary to tap the part into place, use a soft face hammer and tap lightly.



Always follow torque specifications as outlined. Incorrect torquing may lead to serious machine damage or can result in injury or death for the rider.



Cleanliness of parts and tools as well as the work area is of primary importance. Dirt and foreign matter will act as an abrasive and cause damage to precision parts.

WARNING

Whenever installing batteries, care should be taken to avoid the possibility of explosion resulting in serious burns. Always connect the positive (red) cable first and the negative (black) cable last. When working with batteries, always wear safety glasses or a face shield and protective gloves. Battery electrolyte contains sulfuric acid and is poisonous! Serious burns can result from contact with the skin, eyes or clothing. **ANTIDOTE:** External - Flush with water. Internal - Drink large quantities of water or milk. Follow with milk of magnesia, beaten egg, or vegetable oil. Call physician immediately. Eyes - Flush with water for 15 minutes and get prompt medical attention.
